Prayer is such a key element in church planting movements, and we desperately need prayer partners to labour with us in begging Him for eyes that see the harvest, for hearts that break for what breaks His heart, for ears that are open to hear His Word, and for hands and feet that are ready to move and love and serve.

I came up with 8 prayer points using the acronym "M-U-L-T-I-P-L-Y." Please join us in praying for these...

Make Disciples. Pray that we would make disciples not merely converts. Discipleship is about a transformed lifestyle in obedience and submission to Jesus, not just agreement with a system of biblically-based beliefs. (Matthew 28:18-20; Matthew 4:19; Mark 16:15-16)

Unbelievers. Pray for favour and divine appointments with unbelievers. Jesus came to seek and save the lost and He calls us to partner with Him in pursuing those that are far from Him. (Acts 2:47; 5:13; Luke 19:10; John 15; Mark 2:17)

Listen. Pray that God will open our ears, and those we minister to, to hear what the Spirit is saying and then obey. (Mark 4:9; Luke 8:8; Revelation 3:22; 13:9)

ransformation. Pray that we and our disciples would be transformed by the indestructible life inside all who trust and live for Jesus Christ. (Romans 12:2; 2 Corinthians 3:18; 1 Peter 1:1:14-15).

n Christ. Pray that we would maintain focus and grow in passion for Jesus Christ. Life and ministry are constantly trying to draw our attention and affection from simple devotion to Jesus. (Ephesians 1:3:2 Corinthians 11:2; Hebrews 12:2; Revelation 2:4-5; 3:20)

Power of the Spirit. Pray for the release of signs, wonders and miracles through the ministry of the Holy Spirit awakening spiritual hunger and dependency on Christ. (Acts 1:8; 19:11; Romans 15:19; Ephesians 3:16-20; 6:10-18)

Leaders. Pray for labourers to be thrust into the harvest that raise up leaders from the harvest. Pray that these leaders would lead a life of godly character, love, mercy, justice and grace which attracts others to Christ. (Matthew 9:35-38; Luke 10:1-20; 1 Peter 2:12)

**Y** ield. Pray for abundant fruit, that the seed of God's word will yield a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. Pray for fruitful lives transformed by the Gospel as the Holy Spirit connects people to Jesus by faith. (Matthew 13:23; John 15:5-8).
